Information sessions will provide details regarding entry-level jobs in the natural gas industry, the training programs, the application process and work conditions encountered by workers in the gas industry.

- Physically demanding outdoor work requiring long hours in all kinds of weather.
- Some jobs require working 14 consecutive days, 84 hours per week, followed by 14 days off.
- Other jobs work 28 days and have 7 days off.
- Traveling from job site to job site across Pennsylvania and other states is to be expected.



Floorhand training starts February 27th.

If accepted into the 3-week training program, you will acquire basic knowledge and skills necessary for a successful career in the natural gas industry, learn hazard identification and participate in safety awareness training. A gas industry expert will take you through all phases of the industry from drilling and production to completion and distribution operations. Staff will help you develop a resume targeted to the industry and develop job search and interviewing skills. **Class size is limited to 17 students.**

Applicants must have a valid driver's license and will complete a variety of assessments. Following the assessments, applicants will pay for their own physical exam, drug test, and criminal background check (approx. \$170).
